The 2013 hunting season has now begun and it kicked off to a fantastic start in Chirundu with Ted and Larry, two new clients from the US. Congratulations to both Ted and Larry who had phenomenal success hunting elephant and buffalo with bows, guided by Jannie Meyer.

After seeing 63 elephant bulls, on day three Ted made a perfect shot at 20 yards on a good elephant bull (pictured top left and above left). Numerous approaches were made, getting them in the kill zone of a number of elephant bulls.

Larry also made an excellent shot under difficult circumstances at under 30 yards on an old "dagga boy" in the dense early season vegetation (pictured top right). Various plainsgame were also taken on this safari including bushpig (pictured above right), duiker, eland (pictured above centre), giraffe and impala.

All those involved in the hunt thoroughly enjoyed themselves and learned a great deal. Thanks Ted and Larry for some fantastic memories !!!



Down in the south, Marc, guided by Stephen Meyer shot a fantastic hippo bull (pictured left) under very exciting circumstances - well done Marc for keeping your cool ! Marc also harvested a good crocodile (pictured right) on the Runde River. A number of elephant bulls were seen and approached on this hunt including a 55lber on the first day but the quest for a bull over 70lbs is never easy and although an elephant of this size was located, Marc was unable to get a shot before the old bull slipped off.



Further afield in Benin, valued client Gustav had a fantastic 7 day roan hunt guided by Pepe Chelet Snr.

Gustav's roan (pictured left) was harvested in the Djona Safari Area next to Park W.

This roan was the best of the season in the Djona Safari Area - Congratulations Gustav !!!!!

Currently PH Stephen Meyer is on a 10 day hunt in the Gonarezhou area in the south. Jannie Meyer is on another elephant bull hunt in Chirundu/ Nyakasanga in the North and Martin Neuper will shortly be travelling to Cameroon for the first bongo hunt of the season.
