Various plainsgame were also taken on this safari including bushpig, duiker, eland, giraffe and impala. All those involved in the hunt thoroughly enjoyed themselves and learned a great deal. Down in the south, Marc guided by Stephen Meyer shot a fantastic hippo bull (pictured left) under very exciting circumstances—well done Marc for keeping your cool !! A number of elephant bulls were seen and approached on this hunt including a 55lber on the first day but the quest for a bull over 70lbs is never easy and although an elephant of this size was located, Marc was unable to get a shot before the old bull slipped off—next time Marc !!!!
