After several long days hunting elephant "Patient Leon" was rewarded with a great 54lb elephant bull (pictured below centre). Dewet the followed suit bagging his Tuskless Elephant at a mere 12 paces (pictured below left)!!! The rest of the group were not disappointed with Viktor getting his buffalo, Kenny his Hyena and I.D taking a great Kudu Bull (pictured below right) in the twilight hours of the safari.

This was a thoroughly enjoyable hunt which will be remembered fondly by the PH's and clients alike for years to come.
