Fickle winds and dense vegetation thwarted their efforts for the first couple of days but after numerous busted stalks, they managed to sneak up on a group of unsuspecting bulls and Tim was able to pull off a great shot on and the follow-up revealed the mortally wounded buffalo (pictured below centre) -well done Tim!!! Having already previously hunted the majority of plainsgame species, Tim's focus was largely on nyala (pictured below left) and bushbuck which he managed to bag over the remaining days.

They then returned to Harare and said "goodbye" to Tim and "hello" to his mother, Camilla who then arrived for her leg of the adventure to take place in Coutada 9 in Mozambique. A good sable was the main aim of this hunt. Camilla managed to bag herself a very good nyala and warthog (pictured below right) early on in the hunt but patiently held out for a big sable and her patience was rewarded on the ninth day when she took a phenomenal old sable bull (pictured top right) of 43.5 inch—the biggest ever taken in the area!! Huge congratulations Camilla—and, as always a real pleasure to hunt with you and get to spend some quality time with all of you and enjoy Tim's hysterical antics!!!



Shortly afterwards Jannie returned to his favourite "stomping" grounds-Chirundu & Nyakasanga with another familiar face-Peter. Leopard was the order of the day on this hunt and no time was wasted in getting all of the baits out and religiously dragging. It wasn't long before they had action on the baits but it wasn't until the eighth day that a huge tom fed. A blind was quickly put up and that evening Peter managed to make a lethal shot with his 8 x 64. Having a massive leopard (pictured top and below left) in salt they then managed to bag a hyena (pictured below centre), a civet (pictured below right) and a zebra which were all added bonuses.
